





The members of the managing Committee of every shood college or educational Institutions established, owned and or administered by the society, shall be appointed by the presient or in his absence by the vice-presidnet of the Society. The President Shall be the ex officeo Chairman of the managing Committee of such Instituitons.

The managing Committee of every school , College or educational institutions established , owned and or administered by the Society , shall have not less the three members niminated by the president / Vice president of the Society , in addition to theppresident / Chairman and the Secretary thereof and the members

He shall have the power to appoint, remove, dismiss, suspend and employ ee of the institution .
- d) The principal / Headmaster of every educational institution. established, owned or administered by the Society shall be ex officio Secretary of the managing Committee of the institu
- 9. REWARD: The members of the Governing Body as such shall not receive any reward or remuneration whatscever . If however , the membe rs of the Society are appointed or engaged in any one of the works of the Society , they shall be entitled to receive Honoraris for professional services rendered , as teachers : supervisors, or holding any other office in the Society, as the case may be , and be entitled to maintenance , medical case and further training.

10. PRESIDENT : The president shall be that member of the Society of the Brothers of St. Gabriel , who , according to Const tion of the said society , shall be , for the time be ing , the duly appointed provincial , or acting Head , as the gase may be of the religious Province or territory of the sa society and the president shall exercise all such powers m and do all such acts as may be necessary or convenient for the control of the general policies and over - all directic of measures for the promotion or accomplishment of the object of the Society, without prejudice to the generality of

12. TREASURER: The Treasurer is that member of the Governing Body

appointed by the President as the accountant of the Society . He shall exercise all such powers and do all such acts as may be required for the proper conduct of the ordinary business administration of the properties , movable and immovable, of the Society under the general supervision

of the president .
